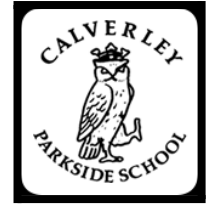


All about me - Autumn 1



Knowledge Organiser

Aims of the theme for learning

- Children to develop positive relationships with children and adults in nursery.
- To share their knowledge of themselves and others, including their family.
- To find out about what we enjoy in nursery, talking about our play, things we like and dislike and our achievements.
- To talk about how we are feeling.
- To listen and respond to what other people say, talking about the same theme of conversation.
- Speak in a simple sentence.
- Ask simple questions to find out more information.

Unique, choice, choose, feelings, happy, excited, sad, sharing, caring.

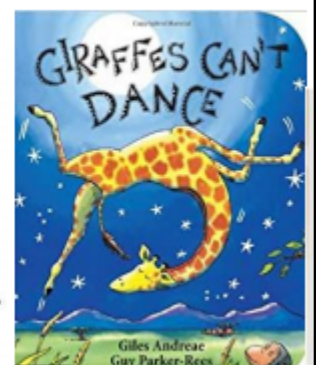
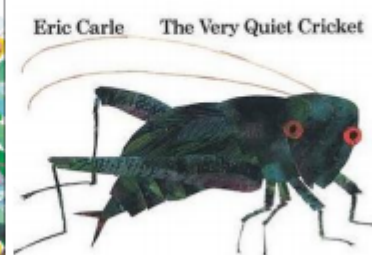
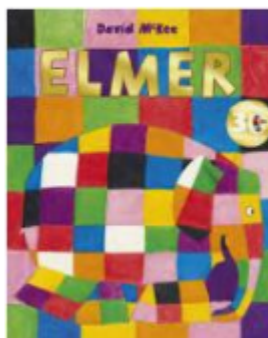

How can you support your child?

- Developing their fine motor skills using playdough, threading or mark making
