The class with the **best punctuality** last week was: Beech (Y1) and Sycamore (Y5)

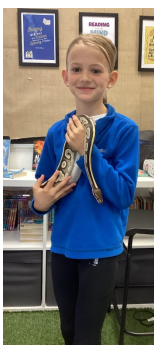
The class with the **most improved** attendance last week was: Willow (Y6)
