Year 6 Annual Leavers water fight in the Park.

In view of the hosepipe ban coming in on Friday 11 July, the cricket club have had to consider what is the right thing to do concerning the end of year water fight in the park.

The club will assist by leaving clean bins out at the side of the club (by the net) from Wednesday for you to store the water in advance of the 18th and if any parents have water butts or other forms of storage, we encourage them to utilise this water for the event and bring it along with them on the day or in advance if possible.

Please note - the water available in the butts at the cricket club will not cater for all children as both schools get involved and multiple year groups. We therefore strongly recommend you bring your own water to use on the day should you want to get involved.

The cricket club also request no balloons as these get stuck in the mowers and cause damage. The cricket club also remind people that water guns are not be brought into the club house for filling at any time.

The club hope that you can all understand, and they wish the Year 6 leavers a fabulous time!
