Mindmate Workshop and Classroom Visit

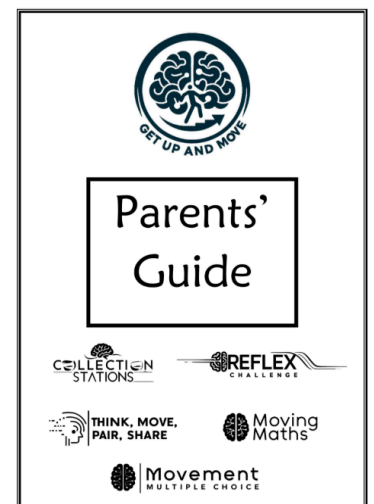

This is open to all year groups. We hold it every Thursday in the Y1 classroom.


Holiday Club - Easter


