**Aim:** To show children how the globe fits together and that our position on it affects the weather and climate we experience.

## Things to talk about at home.

- Where is the North and South pole?
- What are the seasonal and weather patterns we experience?
- How does climate changes affect how humans live?



## Key Knowledge.

- To know where we are on the Earth.
- To know the key physical features of the polar regions.
- How the weather in these areas affect the humans and wildlife.
- To understand how these regions are changing.
- To understand the need to preserve these parts of the world.

## Key Vocabulary.

- Arctic—Polar region in the northernmost part of Earth.
- North Pole—Northern point of the Earth's axis of rotation.
- South Pole—Southernmost point of the Earth.
- Ice Caps—A covering of ice over a large area, especially in the polar regions of the planet.
- Climate Change—Long term shifts in temperatures and weather patterns.
- Seasonal—relating to the characteristic of a particular season.
