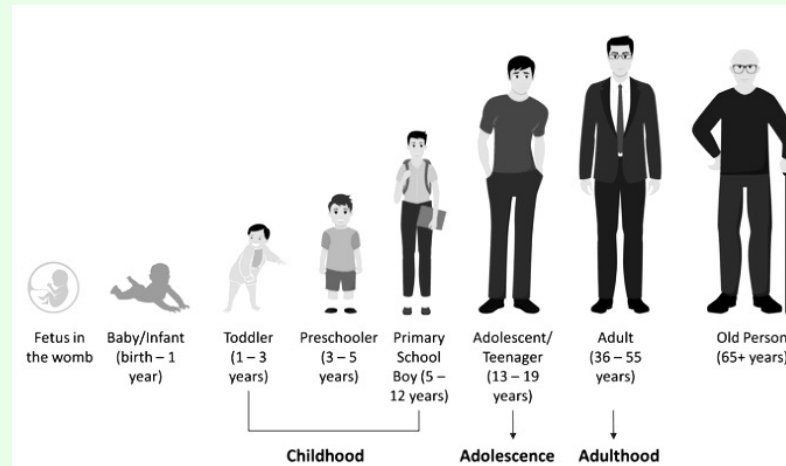


Animals including humans

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Fetus	The unborn offspring.
Infant	A baby under 1 years old.
Child	A person under 18 years old.
Adolescent	A person who is changing from a child to an adult.
Adult	A person over 18 years old.
Puberty	When your body grows and develops to become an adult.
Gestation	The period of development.
Growth	Increase in size.

Key Facts

Humans change as they develop into old age – baby, child, adolescent, adult, elderly.

Changes occur when children go through puberty. For example, growth in height, acne, shoulders broaden in males and hips and breasts in women.

The gestation period in humans is 40 weeks.
